

## Basic Needs

### ***What's New and Different?***

- Data will be collected for the entire agency rather than by specific programs.
- Number of persons served has been separated into two categories: number of clients directly served and additional household members of clients directly served, who will also benefit from the service.
- Changes “persons gaining access to entitlements” to “number of persons who have secured entitlements.”

### **For each AGENCY**

- Number of clients directly served
  - Number of additional household members of clients directly served
  - Of clients directly served, number who have secured entitlements.
  - Number of additional household members of clients who have secured entitlements.
  - Of clients directly served, number receiving emergency food, clothing, and other financial assistance
  - Number of additional household members of clients receiving emergency food, clothing, and other financial assistance
  - Of clients directly served, number receiving case management services
  - Number of additional household members of clients receiving case management services
  - Unduplicated number of clients directly served receiving one or more of previously specified services.
  - Number of additional household members of the unduplicated number of clients directly served.
